I. THE SHEEP'S WATER PROBLEM

A. The setting of Ps. 23 is a semi-arid and rugged mountainous land

B. Each sheep faces three critical needs in such environment

1. They have an absolute need for *daily water*

a. without water, no sheep with thrive or survive for long

b. how much true this is spiritually and to end the Lord *cried:*

If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink! (John 7:38)

2. They have a need for *clean water*

a. though thirsty sheep will drink *any* water, only clean water will profit

b. why are so many true/genuine Christians spiritually weak?

● *For my people have committed two evils: they have forsaken me the fountain of living waters, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no water. (Jeremiah 2:13)*

3. They have need for *still waters*

a. what are the 'still waters' in David's setting?

b. God knows as none other how much we need the *still waters*

● *what profit it a man if he gain the whole world? (Matt 16:26)*

● *Blessed ...who in his law meditates day and night. (Ps. 1:2)*

II. THE SHEPHERD'S LEADING BESIDE THE STILL WATERS

A. The "still waters" is the Shepherd's rich and abundant Gospel water

1. "Still waters" is the message of *His one-sided grace – unconditional love*
 - *When we were yet without strength ... while we yet sinners ... when we were enemies ... Christ died for the ungodly! (Rom. 5:6, 8, 10)*
 - *Is there a greater encouragement to draw near to God than 'him that cometh unto Me, I will in **no wise** cast out?' (John 6:37b)*
2. "Still waters" is *His all atoning blood – covering righteousness*
 - *The blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanseth from all sin (1 John 1:7b)*
 - *Behold the Lam of God which taketh away the sin of the world (John 1)*
3. "Still waters" is His triumphant shout: ***It is Finished!***
 - *Come unto Me, all ye that labor and are heavy burdened, and I will give you rest! (Matt. 11:28)*
 - *And I will satiate the soul of the priests with fatness, and my people shall be satisfied with my goodness, saith the LORD! (Jer 31:14)*
4. "Still waters" is *His promise: **I will never leave thee nor forsake thee***
 - *Eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved (Song 5:1b)*

B. The Shepherd didn't only provide 'still waters', He will lead His sheep to them.
