I. ITS GOD GIVEN PURPOSE

- A. Words aren't a human invention but God's creation
 - 1. God's words set the pattern for how to use our words (Gen. 1))
 - 2. God as Creator of language made us 'stewards of words' (Matt12:36-37)
- B. Main purpose for our words: to love God and our neighbor
 - 1. Examine your 'use of words' in the light of Eph. 4:29

II. ITS SIN TWISTED DEFORMITY

- A. Though fallen, God still requires us to manage our words as He intended
 - 1. Eph. 4 gives many directions on positive side of 9th commandment
 - 2. Every instance of *transgression of* 9^{th} is a proper work of the devil
 - a. false witness:1 Kings 21:13
 - b. falsify any man's words: Gen. 3:1-2; Acts 6:11
 - c. slander (2 Sam. 19:17)
 - d. backbiting/gossip: Prov. 26:22; Prov. 17:9; Prov. 6:19
 - e. judging without knowing all facts: John 9:2; Prov. 18:13
 - f. flattery: Prov. 27:5; 28:23
 - g. promising too much:
 - h. breaking confidences: Prov. 11:13
- B. How does breaking the 9th bring the *heavy wrath of God* upon us?...
 - 1. He will make us reap what we sow (Gal. 6:7-8; Prov. 18:20; 26:27)

III. IT'S GRACE REDEEMED CHARACTER

- A. Ye shall know who the man is by the fruits of his life
 - 1. Words are *fruits* of what lives within the heart (James 4:1-3)
 - 2. Good words bring many blessings to others: Prov. 10:10; 15:4; 16:24)
- B. The 'redemption of our tongue' begins with regeneration of heart

CLOSING OBSERVATIONS

- A. "Political correctness" is mostly a refusal to say the truth
 - 1. For a Christian, honest to the truth is not only the best but the only policy
 - 2. There are no degrees in honesty
- B. Too little of our words are devoted to sharing spiritually (Malachi 3:16)
- C. Let's pray for the fulfillment of Moses's words: Would God that all the LORD'S people were prophets, and that the LORD would up His Spirit upon them. (Numb. 11:29)
