Opening Question

- ➤ Why is knowing you are saved by God's omnipotent grace the greatest comfort in life and death?
- ➤ How does one come to know this comfort?

THE QUESTION: AM I SAVED?

- 1) What is it to be saved? 2) How am I to be saved?
 - 3) How would I know that I am saved?

I. WHAT IS IT NOW REALLY TO BE SAVED?

- A. To be saved lit means 'to make whole' (Acts 5:9)
 - 1. we need this restoration in two aspects
 - a. our relationship with God
 - b. our condition of heart
 - 2. without facing and believing these two truths, we remain unconcerned
- B. To be saved is to undo what sin had done
 - 1. it restores the relationship between God and me (Eph. 2:4-6, 11-13)
 - a. what are the main fruits of this restoration?
 - peace with God: Rom. 5:1
 - adoption as sons and daughters: Gal. 4:5
 - inheritance of eternal dimensions: 1 Peter 1:4; Rev. 21:4
 - all provisions of journey hence: Rom. 8:32
 - certainty that all things work together: Rom. 8:28
 - 2. it restores the condition of our heart (1 Thes. 1:9; Gal. 5:22)
 - a. begins with regeneration to end in full glorification (Rom. 8: 30)
 - b. gradual and (here on earth) incomplete work of Spirit
 - viewing a saved sinner, we can consider such in 2 ways
 - focus on the (remaining) desolation
 - focus on the (progressing) restoration

II. HOW AM I TO BE SAVED?

- A. Crystal clarity is necessity here
 - 1. We are born unsaved even though we are born in church community
 - 2. We are not saved because we are believers of the Christian creed
 - 3. We are not saved by our works
- B. How then is one so lost and sinful saved?
 - 1. By the *power of God exercised* upon us personally
 - a. Catechism speaks about being ingrafted into Christ
 - b. only when the Almighty acts will one be united by faith to Christ
 - man is entirely passive in this work of God: John 1:13; 3:8
 - as fruit of God's work, man becomes active in bearing fruit: Eph. 2:10; 1 Thes 1:3
 - 2. (True saving) faith plays a vital in God's work of saving a sinner

III. HOW DO I KNOW THAT I AM SAVED?

- A. 'By the fruit of the tree' do we know the nature of the any tree
 - 1. impossible to stay the same when united to Christ
 - 2. main and most critical fruit if 'faith' itself

APPLICATION

- A. If God is sole author of salvation, carrying out His eternal will, then I will just wait for Him to act.
 - 1. Watch against Satan's device to make you think ill of God.
 - 2. Be aware than all Scripture doctrine is to encourage us to return
- B. I am so discouraged, feel so unworthy because I am so hard, cold and wicked.
