- A. The setting of Jesus' inaugural sermon
  - 1. Nazareth's synagogue wasn't an unfamiliar place to Jesus
  - 2. Nazareth's vision as a 'settler's town' was very familiar to Jesus
  - 3. Nazareth's favorite passage would have been Is. 60 61:1-8
  - 4. Nazareth's reaction to Jesus' interpretation of Is. 61 infuriated them

## JESUS' KINGDOM

## I. ITS CHARACTER IS LOVE II. ITS BENEFIT IS DELIVERANCE

- I. THE CHARACTER OF JESUS' KINGDOM IS LOVE
- A. Never disconnect the Lord Jesus of His Father Who is love (1 John 4:8b)
  - 1. When we see Jesus' actions we see the Father's love in action (John 3:16)
  - 2. When Jesus is speaking about His Kingdom, He is speaking about love
- B. The character of Jesus' Kingdom is not having but giving (John 13:34-35)
  - 1. His focus is showing and giving love in saving needy sinners (vs. 18)
    - a. I came not to bring material benefits but spiritual benefits to unworthy
    - b. I came not to live self-focused life of pleasure but bring out God's love
    - c. I came not to be religious but to be godly (Is. 58)
- II. THE BENEFIT OF CHRIST'S KINGDOM IS DELIVERANCE
- A. Christ's coming is to bring real deliverance in our life
  - 1. We are in deep trouble because we don't even see our deepest problem

2. Our misery of life is the condition of our heart!  a. you are a captive
b. you are blind
c. you are poor
d. but are you brokenhearted?
B. Christ was sent do everything about that condition of misery 1. I am anointed to preach to acceptable year of Lord (vs. 19)
2. I am anointed to preach the Gospel to the poor!
To the point
A. Do you see your need for this King and His Kingdom?  1. Our deepest need is <i>spiritual</i>
2. Our unhappiness is due to missing of our purpose for living! (Is. 58:10-11)
B. Do not fear to take your refuge to this King of Love and Mercy!
C. Do you consider yourself part of His spiritual Kingdom?
