I. WHO IS THE SECRET OF THIS PEACE ISAIAH SPEAKS ABOUT?

- A. The prophet doesn't just speak about peace but perfect peace
 - 1. Best illustrated with Ps. 46:1-3, Hab. 3:17-18; Matt 8:24
- B. The secret of this peace is not the believer
 - 1. The secret of this *perfect peace* is the *God of peace*
 - 2. The secret of this peace would remain mystery if God didn't reveal it
 - 3. The secret of this peace is unimaginably costly: Is. 53:5
 - 4. The secret of this peace is that God will keep one in peace (Is. 26:3)

II. WHAT IS THE SECRET OF THIS EXPERIENCE OF PEACE?

- A. Only believers who will experience this peace (see Is. 57:21)
 - 1. Because their mind is stayed on Thee a. mind is thought – meditation – desires – inner being
 - b. stayed is *leaning* upon
 - c. Thee: All sufficient and merciful majesty of heaven and earth
 - 2. They 'stay upon Him' because they trust Him
- B. The secret of *experiencing* this perfect peace in through faith 1. Faith is the fruit of God's Spirit
 - 2. Faith in Jehovah is also God's way to minister peace to soul
