## HOPE FOR THE HOPELESS IN JESUS CHRIST 1) OUR CASE PICTURED 2) OUR HOPE ILLUSTRATED

#### I. OUR CASE PICTURED IN THE DEAF AND BADLY SPEAKING MAN

- A. This man pictures our spiritual condition
  - 1. We were created with perfection in our spiritual condition
  - 2. As result of the fall all mankind is *deaf and with impeded speech* a. deaf to God's voice in the Law
    - b. deaf to God's voice in the Gospel
    - c. deaf to God's voice in Providence
    - d. deaf to the language of the redeemed
    - e. as result, unable to speak ably about the spiritual matters
- B. What are we to do with this spiritual condition in ourselves and others? 1. we must bring them to Jesus' feet (vs. 32)
  - 2. we must bring our own condition to Him also for salvation
  - 3. we must wait on Him in faith (Ps. 27:14)

## **II. OUR HOPE ILLUSTRATED IN JESUS' RESPONSE AND ACTIONS**

A. Jesus' first responses are the revelations of the Father's heart (John 1:14; 17:6)

- 1. What was the 'reason' of His remarkable actions in vs. 33? a. taking him aside
  - b. fingers in ears spit/touch tongue looking up

- B. Jesus' sigh reveals more of Father's heart than words can ever say
  - 1. Reveals His deep emotion as He sees this man's misery as result of our Fall
  - 2. Reveals that God isn't unfeeling about seeing the results of sin
  - 3. Reveals His willingness to enter into the misery of sinners as Substitute
- C. Jesus' command reveals the necessity of His Word in salvation (vs. 34b)
  - 1. To be born again is "not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever." (1 Peter 2:23)
