II. THE SONG ABOUT THE WORK OF GOD'S GRACE

- A. The work of grace is celebrated as being saved from our enemies (71, 74)
 - 1. Entirely in line w/ God's revelation of salvation: Gen. 3:15 1 Jo 3.8
 - 2. Zacharias doxology begins to extol God for *having given king* (69) a. why this emphasis on His kingly office?
- B. To accomplish salvation, God uses two agents: John and Jesus
 - 1. John's role is preparatory (Luke 1:16-17)
 - 2. But it is Jesus Who is the actual Deliver (69, 74)
- C. What are the enemies of our soul Jesus' Gospel defeats to save sinners?
 - 1. He defeats Mr. Pleasure in Sin
 - 2. He breaks supremacy of **Mr. Power of sin**
 - 3. He will finally forever eliminate **Mr. Presence of sin**
 - 4. He has to eliminate Mr. Penalty for Sin
 - 5. He has to cast out the bad members of the Ful-family

III. THE FRUIT OF GOD'S GRACE

- A. God's saving grace is not to indulge but to free sinners to serve Him
 - 1. In our fall we became *slaves of the wrong master* but in the salvation we become *slaves of the Right and Good Master*
 - 2. How will I know that I have been 'redeemed?'
- B. Fruit of His grace is transforming sinners into saints
 - 1. They will serve God without fear (74b)
 - a. with earthly masters, we are often filled with dread
 - b. but with Christ as your Lord, there is no need to fear Him
 - because of how He is
 - because of what He does
 - 2. They will serve Him in *holiness and righteousness* (75) a. holiness is to be like God as known in Christ

b. Righteousness is *live right – to do right* according to God's will

Concluding observations and applications

- > All these fruits of grace are fruits of Messiah's work within sinners
 - Holiness is not the way to Christ; Christ is the way to holiness!
- The most powerful influence upon our world is serene, silent beauty of a holy life for that outshines all the world's lights
