1. Where was Samuel's home? **Ramah: 1 Sam. 7:17**
2. To whom did Jesus announce the necessity for a new birth? **Nicodemus: John 3:3**
3. When and by whom was the exhortation spoken, "Be strong and quit yourselves like men?"
By the Philistines when they heard that the ark had been brought into the camp of the Hebrews; 1 Sam. 4:6-9
4. Whom did John the Baptist urge to "bring forth fruits meet for repentance"? **The Pharisees and Sadducees; Matt. 3:8**
5. Quote exactly the angels' Christmas song at Bethlehem. **Glory to God in the highest; an on earth peace; goodwill toward men. Luke. 2:14**
6. What Old Testament leader was a staunch defender of the Sabbath? **Nehemiah: Neh. 13:15-22**
7. What two instances can you share about Solomon's porch? **John 10:23 (Jesus preaching) and Acts 3:11 (Peter's preaching after healing of man at Beautiful Gate)**
8. Who shed the first blood? **God in preparing skins of Adam/Eve (Gen. 3)**
9. How many songs did Solomon write? **One thousand and five (1 Kings 4:32)**
10. Complete the proverbs, "Trust in the LORD with all thine heart ..." **and lean not unto thine own understanding (Prov. 3:5)**
11. Where did Christ heal the man with a withered hand and how did He heal him? **In the synagogue on the Sabbath Day by commanding him to stretch forth his arm (Mark 3:5)**
12. Who said, "Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have given to thee," and to whom did he say it? **Peter at the Beautiful Gate in Acts 3, healing the paralyzed man**
13. Finish the verse, "When we were yet without strength ..." **in due time Christ died for the ungodly (Rom. 5:6)**
14. Of what did God make the rainbow a token? **The promise never to flood the world with a world-wide Flood (Ge. 9:13-15)**
15. What does God's name "Jehovah Jireh" mean? **The Lord will provide (Gen. 22:14)**
16. Complete Paul's sentence, "We are laborers ..." **together with God (1 Cor. 3:9)**
17. Of what ancient hero is it said, that "He was a mighty hunter before the Lord"? **Nimron (Gen. 10:8,9)**
18. To which church was it said, "Be thou faithful unto death?" **Smyrna, Rev. 2:9**

19. How did the Bible describe the fruitfulness of Canaan? **A land flowing with milk and honey Ex. 3:17**
20. Who was it that “kept all these things and pondered them in her heart?” **Mary, the mother of Jesus (Luke 2:19)**
21. To what did Christ compare the coming of the Holy Spirit? **The wind blowing; John 3:8**
21. What was the only day Israel was to fast each year? **The Day of Atonement; Lev. 16:29-31**
22. What was Taberah? **A place in the wilderness where the people murmured against God and were punished by fire from the Lord. Num. 11:1-3**
23. Who were the elders of the Israelites? **Seventy men appointed to aid Moses in governing (Num. 11:16, 17)**
24. Where did the Jews get their idea from to place a Bible text in the phylacteries? (Phylacteries were small leathers boxes some Pharisees carried on their heads) **Deut 6:8**
25. Which deed of Jesus Christ was the fulfilment of the Old Testament Day of Atonement? **The ascension into heaven (Book of Hebrews)**
26. What general was encouraged by Deborah? **Barak; Judges 4:6-9**
27. On what occasion did Moses say, “Would God that all the Lord’s people were prophets?” **When Joshua complained because Eldad and Medad prophesied in the camp: Num. 11:24-29**
28. What was the origin of the saying, “Is Saul also among the prophets?” **When he began to prophesy after Samuel announced that he would become king 1 Sam. 10:5-12**
29. Which king provided the various trees to Solomon for the building of the temple? **Hiram 1 Kings 5:7-11**
30. What did Elijah do for the widow to whom two sons were likely to be taken as a bondmen for debt? **Told her to gather as many vessels as possible and fill them with oil (miraculously) and sell them. 2 Kings 4:1-7**
31. With what event is ‘the sound of going in the tops of mulberry trees’ connected? **A battle and victory by David over the Philistines 1 Chron. 14:13-17**
32. What three signs of his divine mission did the Lord give Moses? **Rod turn into snake; leprous hand; water turn into blood (Ex. 4)**
33. What man seeking to find his father’s asses suggested to see the seer? **Saul’s servant 1 Sam. 9:3:10:1**
34. Finish the quotation, “Weeping may endure for a night but ...” **Joy cometh in the morning Ps. 30:5**
35. Complete the Beatitude, “Blessed is he that watcheth and keepeth ...” **lest he walk naked, and they see his shame. Rev. 16:15**

36. Who owned a run-away slave? **Philemon**
37. What is the longest verse in the Bible? **Esther 8:9**
38. Who was Annas? **Ex-high priest at the time of Christ's trial**
39. What is the "Kingdom Parable" chapter of the Bible? **Matthew 13**
40. Where did Terah die and whose father was he? **He was the father of Abram and died in Haran.**
